WELCOME TO NOVA BALL!

We are thrilled to have you here with us tonight. It's been over two years since we last gathered in this room for Nova Ball, and we are so grateful to be back together.

Tonight we ROAR! together in recognition of the fierceness of two prolific Alums, whose tenacity and resilience through these difficult times have inspired us all. They are shining examples of Ars Nova's greater community of artists who are leading us into these roaring 20s!

We first met **Antoinette Chinonye Nwandu** in 2014 when she applied to our writers' program, Play Group, with an early draft of her play *Pass Over*. After an incredible journey that included productions at Steppenwolf in Chicago, an Off-Broadway Production at Lincoln Center, and a Spike Lee-helmed filmed staging that premiered at Sundance Film Festival and SXSW, *Pass Over* reopened Broadway in August 2021 as the first play to premiere after a 17-month shutdown, with Antoinette serving as both playwright and producer. In addition to being a 2015-2016 member of Play Group, Antoinette received a 2017 commission from Ars Nova to create a new world premiere. She has won numerous prestigious fellowships and awards for her work, including the Lucille Lortel Award for Best Play and the esteemed Whiting Award. If you missed *Pass Over* on Broadway, you can currently stream the filmed version on Amazon Prime.

Similarly, we met **Steven Levenson** as a member of Play Group in 2008-2009. He workshopped his play *Seven Minutes in Heaven* as part of our all new talent festival, ANT Fest 2009, and later joined us as our Playwright-in-Residence, receiving a commission for the world premiere production of his play *Core Values* in 2013. He has since gone on to become a Tony Award-winning playwright, screenwriter, and television writer and producer, writing the book for the six-time Tony Award-winning musical *Dear Evan Hansen*, and the plays *Days of Rage*, *If I Forget* and *The Unavoidable Disappearance of Tom Durnin*. Steven also co-created and executive produced the FX series *Fosse/Verdon*, which was nominated for seventeen Emmy Awards, and most recently wrote the screenplay for Jonathan Larson's *tick*, *tick... BOOM!*, which is currently streaming on Netflix.

In addition to honoring Antoinette and Steven, tonight we celebrate the artists in Ars Nova's commissioning and resident artist programs. These are some of the brightest new talents in New York, and we can't wait to continue developing and sharing their work with you in the decade ahead.

Thank you for being here and thank you for being a part of the Ars Nova family.
